Office Safety Precautions and Procedures in Effect During the Pandemic

My office is taking the following precautions to protect patients and help slow the spread of the coronavirus.

- Appointments will be limited to specific days and times to ensure cleanliness and appointments will be scheduled at specific intervals to minimize the number of people in the waiting room.
- Office seating in the waiting room and in the therapy room has been arranged for appropriate physical distancing.
- Time spent in the waiting room will be reduced. Please wait in your car if possible, and Dr. Conti can text or call you to let you know when you can come up for your appointment.
- While your child is in the therapy room, you can choose to remain in the waiting room, but please limit this to only 1 adult accompanying the child. If you have other children with you, please wait in your car. If you are needed for any reason in the session, Dr. Conti will contact you.
- Adults are required to wear masks and remain 6 ft. apart.
- Restroom soap dispensers are maintained and everyone is encouraged to wash their hands.
- Hand sanitizer that contains at least 60% alcohol is available in the therapy room and waiting room.
- Contactless payment methods are preferred, such as Venmo, PayPal, or Chase Quick Pay. If you need to write a check, please do so in advance to minimize the use of pens as well as reduce the need to touch surfaces. Any necessary paperwork may also be completed and submitted electronically.
- Physical contact is not permitted.
- Tissues and trash bins are easily accessed. Trash is disposed of on a frequent basis.
- Lysol spray is used on all surfaces in between each patient.
- All areas are thoroughly disinfected at the end of each day.

If at anytime you do not feel comfortable, please discuss with Dr. Conti.

If at anytime you prefer to switch to telehealth, please discuss with Dr. Conti.

If there is an increase in the number of cases, or if businesses are shut down again in the future, Dr. Conti may choose to discontinue face-to-face sessions and resume telehealth, for the safety and well-being of all patients.
